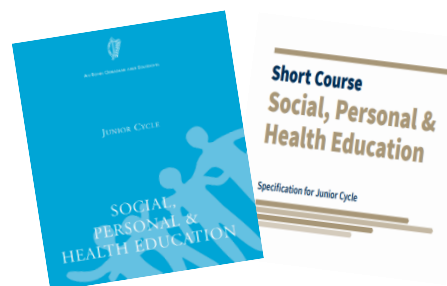


Post Primary Mental Health Seminar event
